In the instant petition, the petitioner has sought for direction to the respondents to regularize the petitioner's services from the date when services of his junior were regularized.

Learned State counsel has placed on record order dated 21.11.2002 to show that the petitioner's services were regularized on 21.11.2002 w.e.f. 1.4.1993.

During the pendency of this petition, the petitioner is stated to have passed away on 27.5.2009. Thus, the petition do not survive for consideration. However, the legal representatives are directed to approach the concerned department, if any, service benefits are due to the deceased Jaipal. If such representation/application is made by the legal representatives of the petitioner late Shri Jaipal, the concerned authority is directed to consider and extend all the benefits in accordance with law.

With the above observation, the petition stands disposed of.
