It was a suit for recovery which was decreed by learned trial court vide impugned judgment and decree dated 19.3.1987. First appeal of the defendant was dismissed by learned first appellate court vide impugned judgment and decree dated 6.5.1988.

Notice of motion order dated 6.2.1989 and numerous later orders passed by this Court, including admission order dated 12.1.1990, would show that there was no interim order, staying execution of the impugned decree, probably for the reason that it was a money decree.

In view of the above and in all probability, the impugned decree, would have been executed and satisfied long back and the present appeal has become redundant.

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Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the appellant to press this appeal, nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that appellant is not interested in pursuing the present appeal any further.

In view of the above, instant appeal is dismissed for non prosecution.
