Convict Parvesh @ Nitu has filed the present appeal for challenging the judgment and order dated 3/4.9.2013.

Vide impugned judgment and order, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak, convicted the appellant under Section 392 IPC and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of seven years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo imprisonment for two months. He was also convicted under Section 397 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of seven years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo imprisonment for two months. He was further convicted under Section 25 of the Arms Act

and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of three years and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo imprisonment for one month. All the substantive sentences were ordered to run concurrently. The period, during which, he had remained in custody during the period of investigation and trial of the case was ordered to be set off against the sentence awarded.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate, as per which, the sentence awarded to the appellant in the present case has since expired after giving the benefit of under-trial period, conviction period and earned remission. Further, the sentence in lieu of fine would start after the expiry of other sentences awarded in other cases.

In view of the above, the appeal is hereby dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
