The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking a direction to the respondents to acquire the land owned by them and pay the compensation.

It is pleaded that part of the land owned by the petitioners was used by the Municipal Council, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, for widening of the existing road. Despite repeated requests, neither the land was acquired nor any compensation was paid.

The stand in the reply is that the road has been constructed at the spot.

None has appeared for the petitioners. However, still considering the fact that the land has been utilized, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to respondent no. 1 to examine the matter and take a decision thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order. In case the land owned

by the petitioners has been utilised for widening of the road, they deserve to be compensated for that.

Ordered accordingly.

Since no one has appeared for the petitioners, let a copy of the order be sent to the petitioners.
