Learned counsel for the applicant restricts the arguments with regard to the observation made by learned trial Court dismissing the complaint filed by the complainant under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act having been a pre-mature complaint.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that while dismissing the complaint on the ground that the same is pre-mature, no permission was granted by the trial Court to file a fresh complaint at appropriate stage.
