It is a seniority matter going into the remote past with the petition filed in 1997. There is a single petitioner and 291 private respondents. Mr. K.K. Gupta, Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent-Corporation states that petitioner was born on 19.05.1948. The prayer in the writ petition was for refixation of seniority AG-II(D) from Serial No. 3643 to 3044. Interference at this distance of time would involve administrative chaos which should be avoided by refraining to pass orders in the writ jurisdiction in cases which come up after decades of the cause of action which may tend to unsettle settled things.

The file is closed and sent to the record room as it has been rendered mostly infructuous.
