The present application under Section 378(3) Cr.P.C. has been filed by the victim for grant of leave to appeal filed against the judgment dated 10.8.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad to the extent of acquitting respondents No.2 and 3 of the charges against them.

For the same relief, the State of Haryana had earlier filed CRM A-762-MA of 2017 which came up for preliminary hearing before a co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 10.7.2017 when after hearing learned State counsel, the Bench came to the conclusion that the trial Court had rightly doubted the version of

the prosecution as regards the charges framed against respondents No. 2 and 3 herein. Accordingly, the leave to appeal was declined.

In view of the above, the present application filed by the victim is also dismissed and leave to appeal declined.
