It is agreed that this writ petition is similar to a group of the writ petitions, one of which is in the case of Mohan Singh Vs. Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh and others CWP No.14300 of 1996. Those petitions were disposed of by an order and judgment of a Division Bench of this Court dated 05.12.2013.

This writ petition is also, therefore, disposed of in the same terms. However, the position of the availability of dwelling units as recorded in that judgment may not be the same today after a period of over 3 ½ years. In the event of the premises not being available, the petitioners shall be at liberty to claim alternate premises or such any other alternate remedy in accordance with law.

The respondents shall comply with this order by 31.12.2017.
