Notice in the application for condonation of delay was issued in this case. As per office note, respondent No. 2 was reported to have passed away. This matter was adjourned on 13.12.2016 to enable the learned counsel for the State to verify this fact.

Report dated 19.04.2017 by way of affidavit of Sh. Dayama Harish Kumar (IPS) Assistant Commissioner of Police, Cantonment Jalandhar is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

It is mentioned that respondent No. 2 - Pardeep Singh son of Ranbir Singh has passed away on 03.02.2016. Death certificate is attached as Annexure R3/T with this affidavit. Joint statement of Panchayat members of village Buteri, District Alwar, Rajasthan i.e. the native place of the deceased, is also attached with this affidavit as Annexure R4/t.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in view of the death of respondent No. 2, the present application seeking leave to appeal against judgment dated 16.03.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar acquitting respondent No. 2 of the charge under Section 306 IPC has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the facts and circumstances, this application/appeal is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
