The present application has been filed under Section 378(4) Cr.P.C. for grant of special leave to appeal against the judgment of acquittal dated 9.12.2016 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar.

Learned counsel for the applicant contended that the impugned order is based on conjectures and surmises and without proper appreciation of evidence and documents on record.

The learned trial Judge has passed the impugned order on the basis of material evidence available on record and had recorded observation that there was no legal liability for issuance of cheque and at this stage, there is nothing to controvert the said fact. The present application is without any merit.

Resultantly, the present application is dismissed.
