ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.25 dated 24.02.2016 under Sections 279/337/338 IPC registered at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is an outcome of an accident in which daughter of respondent No.2 had received minor injuries. She has fully recovered and the matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 22.09.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has sent her report dated 12.10.2017, wherein it

is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of an accident in which minor injuries were caused to the daughter of respondent No.2, who has now fully recovered and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.25 dated 24.02.2016 under Sections 279/337/338 IPC registered at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
