Vide award of the Labour Court dated 15.2.2001 the respondent-workman was ordered to be reinstated with full back wages. The Management challenged the aforesaid award by way of present writ petition. The writ petition of the management was confined only to the payment of back wages. However, while admitting the writ petition no stay was granted regarding the payment of back wages. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the workman has since been reinstated and has been paid current wages. He states that however, back wages have not been paid. The workman had filed a petition under Section 33 C (2). The Labour Court had awarded a sum of ₹ 44200/- vide award dated 3.12.2003. The said order was challenged by way of writ petition bearing CWP No. 12801 of 2004. Though the writ petition was admitted but stay was specifically declined after the workman had appeared. In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate to order that if the back wages have not been paid despite order under Section 33 C(2) respondent-workman may take

necessary steps in that behalf in accordance with law, if so advised.
However, at this stage, the case is consigned to record-room with liberty to the parties, to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
