The petitioner has sought for direction to the respondents to consider his name for promotion to the post of Accountant.

During the pendency of the petition, on 23.7.1999, the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Accountant in the pay scale of Rs.1400-2600 pre-revised scale w.e.f. 22.11.1990. In the written statement, grant of consequential benefits of re-fixation of seniority and re-fixation of pay and arrears of pay between 1999 to this day is silent.

Accordingly, concerned respondent-Transport Commissioner is directed to re-fix the petitioner's seniority, pay and arrears and calculate difference of pay from 23.7.1999 to upto date and disburse the same alongwith interest @ 6% per annum within a period of four months from today.

With the above observation, petition stands allowed.
