Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.101 dated 30.12.2015, under Section 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 29.08.2017. Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed. Part of the settled amount has been handed over to respondent no.3. The petitioner undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 affirms and verifies the factum of settlement between the parties. It is submitted that

his clients have no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Amrik Singh, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, especially the settlement between the parties, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 30.03.2016, is made absolute.
