Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioner having a civil suit decree in his favour, restraining respondents no.5 to 9 herein from interfering in his possession over the land in question, the said respondents allegedly continue to harass and threaten him, in respect of which various representations have been made by the petitioner to different police authorities, but allegedly with no result.

Without making any comment on the merits of the aforesaid contention, except to the extent that a copy of a decree dated 05.12.2015 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Jalalabad (West), has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-3, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka (respondent no.3 herein), to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioner are duly protected and that the respondents do no interfere in his possession of the suit land, except in due course of law.

If, of course, the aforesaid decree has been appealed against with success by the private respondents, that issue would naturally be gone into by the SSP, Fazilka.
