This is second petition by the petitioner for regular bail.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel submits that there are two more additional cases are registered against the petitioner under the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is on bail in those cases.

In the present case, however, the petitioner has undergone imprisonment for a period of 01 year 03 months and 25 days.

In view of the fact that there are multiple cases of NDPS Act are registered/pending against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is directed complete the trial before 31.07.2017.
