The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.188 dated 30.11.2006, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Mahilpur (now Police Station Mehtiana), District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused stands acquitted vide judgment, Annexure P-2.

However, on the strength of acquittal of co-accused, no benefit can be passed to the petitioner as the petitioner evaded the process of the Court and was declared proclaimed offender on 10.05.2010 and subsequently could be arrested only in the month of April, 2016.

Keeping in view the conduct and antecedents of the petitioner, no case of bail is made out. Consequently, the petition is

dismissed.

However, considering the fact that co-accused stands acquitted, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
