The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance direction to decide the application filed under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 bearing case No.CHI-692/15 dated 14.10.2015, titled as “Jasbir Singh vs. Ravinder Singh Parmar and others” pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to para No.7 of the reply filed on behalf of respondent no.6, Deputy Director, Department of Social Security and Women & Child Development, Punjab, Chandigarh to contend that for submission of Domestic Incident Report in a complaint, time limit has been prescribed to decide such like cases. As per Annexure P2 the matter is pending before the JMIC, Jalandhar since 2015. Now report of CDPO has been received.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court feels that the purpose of filing the present would be achieved in case the direction is issued to the trial Court to ensure that the matter is concluded expeditiously particularly when the the State has specifically prescribed the time limit for submission of Domestic Incident Report to the Magistrate and in view of the time limit so prescribed by the State, learned counsel for the parties assure that they will fully cooperate in the matter.

The present petition is disposed of in the above terms.
