The present petition has been filed under Section 340 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for registration of an FIR against respondent No.2.

Vide order of even date, the following order has been passed by this Court in a connected petition i.e. CRM-M No.563 of 2017:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners or implicate them in any false case at the instance of respondent No.4 on account of solemnization of marriage by the petitioners against the wishes of respondent No.4.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Gurwinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sri Hargobindpur, District Batala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per para 3 of the reply, it is submitted that the enquiry into the complaint was conducted and statement of both the petitioners were recorded in which they have

stated that they do not want any police protection and they are residing happily together. A copy of statements of the petitioners is also annexed with the reply as Annexure R1/T in which they have stated that they are living peacefully and enjoying a happy married life and do not need any police protection.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach this Court again in case, the petitioners still feel any threat to their life and liberty.”

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
