Learned State counsel submits that investigation in the instant case has been completed. Total eight accused have been found involved including the applicant Parminder Singh @ Sodhi son of Kartar Singh. Final report has also been submitted in Court. The applicant-Parminder Singh @ Sodhi is still at large and could not be arrested despite repeated raids.

In view of the above, the application is dismissed.

CRM No.M-11053 of 2016

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to hand over the investigation of the case in FIR No.20 dated 24.02.2016 under Sections 302/148/149 of the IPC and Section 25/54 of the Arms Act

registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur to some independent agency as due to political pressure, police was trying to hush up the matter. The main accused Parminder Singh @ Sodhi has not been arrested yet, though his name finds mention in the FIR. The complainant apprehends that the police would destroy the evidence and has also very serious threats to his life and liberty.

Considering the the fact that police has submitted the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. against eight persons, the apprehension of the petitioner that the police would destroy the evidence has rendered meaningless and as such, there is no necessity to call any status report.

The petition is dismissed accordingly.
