Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of directions to the respondents no.2 to 4 to conduct free, fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.71 dated 28.05.2016 under Sections 306/384/385/511/34 IPC registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel refers to the status report filed on behalf of Varun Sharma, IPC, Assistant Superintendent of Police,

Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur and submits that in the aforesaid FIR, police has already completed the investigation and cancellation report has been presented before the Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the police has already completed the investigation and filed cancellation report, this Court finds that the prayer of the petitioner no more survives.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to contest the cancellation report, if so advised, in accordance with law.
