The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in FIR No.216 dated 31.10.2014, registered under Sections 457, 454, 380, 379 and 411 IPC and Section 21 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

It is contended that the petitioner was earlier granted the bail in the present FIR, however, on one date i.e. 26.11.2015, he could not appear before the trial Court as he was arrested in another FIR No.240 dated 26.11.2015 and FIR No.241 dated 26.11.2015. Therefore, vide order dated 26.11.2015, non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel has furnished the

chart of the cases in which the petitioner is involved. Same is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

I have heard the learned State counsel and carefully perused the entire file.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is involved in as many as 11 FIRs mentioned in the chart, it emerges that the petitioner is a habitual offender. Therefore, no case is made out for bail.

Dismissed.
