Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This is a petition seeking regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.113 dated 09.05.2008, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 452, 460, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ellanabad, District Sirsa. Petitioner was arrested on 23.09.2015 and is in jail since then.

I have seen the FIR and the attribution to the petitioner.

Mr. Bimal Maini, Advocate appears for the complainant-wife who also received injury. Learned counsel submits that the complainant-wife intends to compromise/compound.

Mr. Rahul Vats, Advocate appears for victim-Reshma Devi and opposes the present petition for bail. He submits that victim-

Reshma Devi also received injury and therefore, she is entitled to oppose the petitioner.

There is no doubt that victim-Reshma Devi is entitled to oppose the petition for bail to the petitioner. However, looking to the nature of injuries caused to the complainant as well as Reshma Devi and period spent by the petitioner in jail with the further fact that challan has been filed and with further fact that the trial will take its own time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
