Pursuant to the order dated 24.03.2017, an affidavit of Sh. Rajiv Deswal, H.P.S., D.S.P. Gohana, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, stating therein that initially the petitioner himself had reported that when his son, Neeraj, was returning home at about 7:25 p.m. on 07.12.2016, he was hit by some unknown vehicle, due to which he fell down and sustained injuries and that when the person accompanying the aforesaid Neeraj, i.e. one Ram Chander, who was travelling on his own motor-cycle, was looking after Neeraj, the driver of the vehicle that had hit Neeraj sped away in the darkness.

However, subsequently the petitioner had started filing applications stating that it was actually his sons' wife, his father-in-law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law who had got the petitioners' son killed (due to a matrimonial dispute) and that action be taken accordingly.

It is further stated in the affidavit that now, vide DDR No. 18 dated 06.04.2017, offences punishable under Sections 302/120-B read with Section 34 IPC were added in the FIR, and that the matter is still under investigation, which would be carried out impartially (as stated in the affidavit).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on the other hand, submits that though the aforesaid addition has been made in the FIR, however, allegedly the petitioner and his family are being threatened by those accused in the FIR.

This petition is consequently disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat (respondent no. 2), to ensure that a fair and impartial investigation is carried out and that the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family are duly protected.
