The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.235 dated 8.10.2016, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, PS Cantonment Amritsar, District Amritsar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 28.3.2017, report of the learned JMIC, Amritsar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
