In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with an observation that since petitioner no.1 is below 21 years of age, i.e. the legally marriageable age for males, no order of this Court shall be treated to a bar on any proceedings initiated under the provisions of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006, against him.
