Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though he has not been able to contact any officer of the petitioner-company, however, as per the information available on internet, the petitioner company was taken over by M/s Digvijay Chemicals. The land in question was declared surplus. It was allotted to some one and M/s Digvijay Chemicals has purchased from that allottee.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the prayer made in the present petition seeking acquisition of land has become infructuous. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed. However, in case any claim is still left, the petitioner shall be at liberty to get the present petition revived within three months.
