Petitioner-Arif @ Soorma has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.106 dated 14.05.2016, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewat, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations in the FIR, the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. However, no specific role has been attributed to him, rather role is of general in nature with the other co-accused.

As per learned State counsel, only *danda* has been recovered from the present petitioner and there is no injury caused by way of *danda*.

The petitioner has been in custody since 03.12.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
