This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No. 8 to 10, parents and brother of petitioner No. 1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) submitted by petitioners to Superintendent of Police, Ambala as now the petitioners are living at Barara, District Ambala. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1- Roma Dahiya is 01.12.1988 as per copy of Secondary Education Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) and that of petitioner No.2- Sukant Chawla is 30.07.1987 as per copy of Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-3). They got married on 22.03.2017. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-7.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners,

but without expressing any opinion on the validity of marriage of

petitioners, petition is disposed of with direction to Commissioner of Police, Ambala, to look into the representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with representation in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
