This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 77 dated 31.08.2016, under Section 304-B IPC (Later on Section 306 IPC has been altered/replaced with Section 304-B IPC), registered at Police Station, Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased. She is in custody since 03.09.2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, has informed the Court that there are 12 prosecution witnesses to be examined before the trial Court. The complainant has been examined-in-chief. Now, an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. is pending consideration before the trial Court. She has further informed that at present, 08 months old child of the deceased is residing with the petitioner.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda.
