The present petition has been filed under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr. P. C for issuance of a direction to the respondent to release the petitioner on interim bail on account of his daughter's wedding.

Affidavit of ASI Birbal Sharma, 338/(GRP), posted at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur (Punjab) filed by the learned State counsel in Court today is ordered to be taken on record. Copy of the same has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the afore-referred affidavit, after verification, the averments made by the petitioner that his daughter's wedding is fixed for 04.04.2017 have been found to be correct. Further no apprehension with regard to any breach of peace by the petitioner or tampering with the evidence on the petitioner's release has been raised.

On instructions from ASI Birbal Sharma, learned State counsel has further submitted that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, enabling the petitioner to attend the marriage of his daughter which is fixed for 04.04.2017, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur, the petitioner is directed to be

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released on interim bail today by 5:00 PM. The petitioner shall surrender before Superintendent, District Jail Sangrur on 07.04.2017 by 5:00 PM.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
