The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R. No.45 dated 6.5.2003 under sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Bilga, District Jalandhar, on the basis of a compromise, which as per counsel has been entered into with the complainant party.

It, however, stands conceded that petitioner no.1 has already been declared a Proclaimed Offender on account of having not joined trial proceedings.

This Court would not be inclined to entertain a quashing petition at the hands of a Proclaimed Offender.

At this stage, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition and submits that he would raise a challenge to the P.O order on the grounds that may be available to him in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
