ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.105 dated 06.05.2014 under Sections 324/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a family dispute which has now been resolved with the intervention of respectables. He further states that only simple injuries were caused to the complainant.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 28.03.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa

Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot, has sent her report dated 28.04.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a family dispute which has been resolved and only simple injuries were caused in the incident.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.105 dated 06.05.2014 under Sections 324/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridkot and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
