FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 18.2.2017 from the conscious possession of petitioner Manjeet Singh 3 kg. and 200 grams poppy husk was recovered and he has committed offence under Section 15 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 18.2.2017 and the quantity recovered is non-commercial and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Though, the factual scenario as far as recovery is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Keeping in view that the non-commercial quantity of

the contraband has been recovered that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
