This order will dispose of a bunch of petitions bearing CWP
Nos. 9643 and 10635 of 1994, 5645 of 1999, 11672 to 11674 and 11861 of
2007, as the issues involved in all the petitions are common.

Challenge has been made in the bunch of petitions to the
acquisition and subsequent proceedings pertaining to acquisition of land at
Pathankot. The scheme is known as 228 Acres Scheme.

Learned counsel for the parties submitted that the issues raised in the present bunch of petitions have already been gone into by this court finally in LPA No. 205 of 2003—Amolak Singh and others v. The Pathankot Improvement Trust, Pathankot and others, decided on 1.10.2010, whereby the order passed by the learned Single Judge directing the Improvement Trust and State to re-consider the matter has been upheld.

For the detailed reasons recorded in Amolak Singh's case (supra), the petitions are disposed of in the same terms.
