Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.702 dated 02.11.2016 registered under Sections 120-B, 420 and 218 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, on the basis of compromise dated 11.03.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 27.03.2017 passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners as also respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 05.04.2017 for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the

parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Assandh, on 05.04.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide covering letter bearing No.96 dated 11.04.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Karnal vide letter bearing No.5276 dated 11.04.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Assandh, the parties have compromised the matter without any pressure from any corner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid FIR No.702, is quashed qua petitioners Bijender Singh, Surender Singh, Sheopal and Mitterpal Singh only.
