Petitioner-Mani Dhawan has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 19.04.2016, registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar, under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Sukhbir Kaur. As per the allegations, on 18.04.2016, the complainant was going to attend her duties and when she reached near Guramrit Hospital, then one Hindu gentleman came from behind and snatched her purse containing two ATM cards and ₹2,000/- and after that, he had withdrawn the amount from the ATM.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner which is taken on record.

Custody certificate shows that the present petitioner is also involved in three other cases of similar nature under Section 379-B IPC and has been convicted in two other cases under Section 382 IPC and Sections 379/411 IPC.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is involved in so many cases, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
