Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.24 dated 02.05.2016, under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, the petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is genuine.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.24 dated 02.05.2016, under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal

Code (for short 'IPC') and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
