This is a petition seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.43 dated 21.02.2017, under Sections 272, 417, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 7/16 of Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 and Section 26/59 of Food Safety & Standard Act, 2006 added later on, registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari. The petitioner was arrested and is in jail.

I have seen the report of the Food Analyst. The report shows presence of un-indicated milk. At any rate, there is no justification for continuing the detention of the petitioner pending trial looking to the nature of offence that has been committed.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the

Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
