He further, on query, submits that as per information available with him, the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Keeping in view the aforesaid but without making any comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioner, I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
