Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was earlier also admitted to interim bail, which he never misused and only after the chemical examiners' report was received, and it was found that the quantity of the contraband stated to have been seized from the petitioner was 50 grams of buprenorphine, with more than 20 grams being commercial quantity, that he has been taken into custody again.

As per the custody certificate filed in Court today by learned State counsel, the petitioner is not seen to be involved in any other criminal case.

Thus, with only one witness having been examined out of eight, and the petitioner already having been in custody since August, 2016, in the aforesaid circumstances, I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
