On 06.04.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:

“As per statement of the victim in the

FIR as well as under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she

has implicated Sinder Kaur, her sister-in-law,

who had poured kerosene oil on her and

thereafter, lit a matchstick.

Petitioner is an old lady and is mother-in-law of the deceased. Her presence has been shown at the time of occurrence.

The complicity of the petitioner would be a debatable issue, in view of the family dispute arising out of uneven distribution of land and tubewell.

Adjourned to 24.05.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 12.04.2017 and in the event of her appearance, she shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance of

order dated 06.04.2017.

The aforesaid fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Gurmel Singh and she further submitted that the petitioner is no more required in further investigation of the case..

In view of above, interim order dated 06.04.2017 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
