Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.190 dated 13.10.2010, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana City, the petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 17.01.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Ludhiana stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is voluntarily and without any pressure.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.190 dated 13.10.2010, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered

at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana City alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed qua petitioners only by way of compounding/compromise.
