Petitioner-Darshan Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.15 dated 12.02.2017, registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala, under Sections 353, 332 and 186 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that in the present case, FIR has been got registered by complainant-ASI Gurtej Singh. As per the FIR, when the complainant alongwith Head Constable Raffi Mohammad was checking the vehicles, then two cars i.e. I-20 and Swift came there. When they tried to stop the said cars, then Buta Singh and Harjinderpal Singh @ Sunny came out from the said cars and objected them. In the meantime, petitioner-Darshan Singh also came from the nearby houses and started abusing the police party. They also attacked on the police party. Buta Singh

gave fist blow on the right eye of the complainant; the petitioner gave fist blow on his face and Harjinder Pal Singh gave push to him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case,I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
