This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 66 dated 08.09.2015, under Sections 306 and 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Marriage of Seema (deceased) was solemnized with Palwinder Singh on 09.12.2012. As per allegations in the FIR, on 15.04.2015, the deceased was turned out from her matrimonial house. Thereafter, on 05.09.2015, her father-in-law Baldev Singh, mother-in-law Kashmir Kaur and other respectable persons had taken her back to the matrimonial house. Husband of the deceased was working in Dubai. Present petitioners are unmarried sisters-in-law of the deceased and are in custody since 08.09.2015. Minor child of the deceased is staying with the father of present petitioners.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioners and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioners any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
