Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is one of a family against whom allegations of beating have been made. However, he submits that the petitioner being 80 years old, has been only falsely roped in, being part of the same family and he has been in custody since 01.05.2016.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, submits that out of 11 witnesses, one has been examined so far.

Though it is a case of a double murder, keeping in view the age of the petitioner and the stage of the trial, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail, upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
