This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 01.03.2017 registered under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.6, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner had run away from the spot as such nothing was recovered from him.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in this FIR, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

In the event of failure of the petitioner to join the investigation, this order of mine shall come to end.

Disposed of accordingly.
