Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner intends to surrender before the trial Court and craves indulgence of this Court that in the event of his surrender, his prayer for regular bail may be considered within three days.

Petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender/ proclaimed person in a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act after his appearance and issuance of notice of accusation.

No date is fixed before the trial Court as the witnesses have already been examined by the complainant in preliminary evidence. Trial Court was of the opinion that there was no need

to fix the date of evidence under Section 299 Cr.P.C. and record was consigned and it was ordered that the case be put up as and when the petitioner is arrested or made to surrender.

In view of above, let the petitioner appear before the trial Court within a period of one week and in the event of his appearance and filing application for the grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within three days in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
