Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.51 dated 25.02.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to

custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find it a fit case, where the petitioners are entitled to benefit of grant of anticipatory bail. Therefore, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 29.03.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
