The application is allowed and statements of witnesses (Annexure P-5) recorded before the trial Court are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CRL. MISC. No.M-10675 OF 2017

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.63 dated 19.06.2016 registered under Sections 302, 323 & 149 IPC at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested in this FIR on 23.06.2016 and since then he is in jail.

I have perused the evidence (Annexure P-5) recorded before the trial Court placed on record by learned counsel for the petitioner today. Upon

looking at the evidence, *prima facie*, I find that the petitioner would be entitled to grant of regular bail.

In the result, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-10675 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition on the part of the petitioner, the liberty is reserved in favour of the complainant/State to apply for cancellation of bail.
